Winemaking note

The selected Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are gently removed from the stems, and remain intact when deposited in our 240 Hl stainless steel tanks for a two days pre-fermentation maceration, which helps releasing the color and flavor from the skin. Then, during the fermentation process, a pumping over is carried on twice a day, allowing the juice to be in constant contact with the skin all over the process. This results in a more intense color of the Cabernet Sauvignon. Once or twice during the whole fermentation process, the entire tanks are pumped over and replaced immediately back. The Cabernet Sauvignon post-fermentation maceration lasts between seven and fourteen days. It is followed by a malolactic fermentation. Then a part of the final blend is aged in French oak barrels during a period of four months.

Tasting note

Behind its deep purple color, this Cabernet Sauvignon reveals intense aromas of black fruits, plum and a hint of flowers and dry leaf, complemented with toffee and caramel notes. It is round, well-balanced in the mouth, with soft and silky tannins and features notes of wood and blackberry aromas.
