VARIETIES : 60% Syrah, 30% Cabernet-Sauvignon and 10% Malbec.

TERROIR: soil consisting of molasses and oyster limestone, in the Soubergues des Coteaux d'Ensérune terroir. Altitude: 50 metres. Hot and dry Mediterranean climate bringing out the power and complexity of this exceptional wine.

YIELD : 25 hl/ha.

AGING : Malbec (10% of the wine) is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels of two wines, with a special selection of the finest grapes to develop the wines' length and finesse.

TASTING NOTES : dark red appearance with hints of purple. Complex bouquet of cardamom, alcohol-soaked fruit and tobacco leaf. Liquorice notes and a wonderful freshness on the palate. Intense finish supported by caramelised notes.

PAIRING : excellent with rabbit and olives, red mullet pie or a veal and mushroom tartine.
