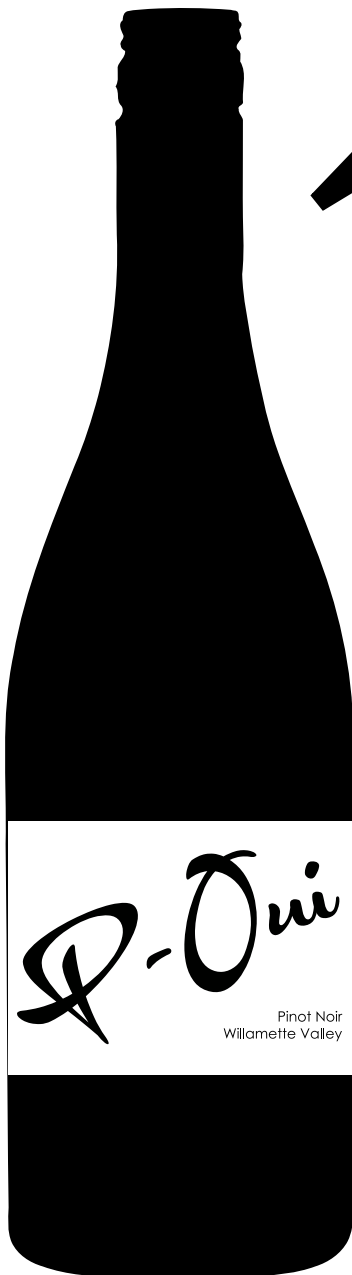




**2015 P-Oui

Mouton Noir Wines: Garage Wines (Micro-Negociant) focusing on specific terroirs in Oregon by sourcing the best fruit possible from the Willamette Valley region of Oregon to produce wines which show the individuality of their respected sites.

Grapes: We source our fruit from several of the finest vineyards in the Willamette Valley, it is this combination of grapes from a variety of appellations that creates a wine that is broad and complex with many layers.

Winemaking: Fruit was picked during the 2nd week of September, after a most ideal growing season, the 2015 harvest was the hottest and longest ever. 7 day cold soak, with an additional 18 days of skin contact, fermented in stainless steel; aged in French oak 25% new oak; aged 12 months. The 2015 P-Oui "One Pinot Under a Groove". Only bottled in half bottles to complement dining alone or enjoying a glass with a friend!
