Phantasmagoria: red black blue fruit chocolates flowers spices textures depth breadth. Velvet stone smoke cinnamon kelp playdough grip supple rich minerals. Stupid. Smart. Tasty.

FOUNDERS' NOTES:

First produced in 2012, **Holler** is named for Red Hollow, the place where Chris's parents live in Knoxville, Tennessee. The theory behind the wine is simple: once the barrels for Kingpin, Rainmaker and Evermore are selected, the remaining barrels (plus some other Bordeaux varietals) become **Holler**. These barrels are good enough to become the #21 wine in the world on *Wine Spectator's* 2016 Top 100. This wine heads our over delivery tier, having received a 94 point score for the 2013. Tastes great too.
