

Horizon du Sud Pinot Noir

Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Colour : Red

Vineyard: French winemaking heritage counts a number of grape varieties which have an unrivalled reputation throughout the world. Horizon du Sud is a wine produced from a single grape variety. This Pinot Noir is produced from carefully selected wines from the Mediterranean region, renowned for their intense fruit aromas and round structure

<u>Vinification</u>: This wine undergoes direct pressing before being vinified in temperature controlled stainless steel vats. It is aged during 6 months before being bottled immediately in order to preserve its fresh fruit aromas.

<u>Tasting</u>: Clear and bright colour with red reflections. The nose has little berry notes. The palate is Light and balanced, we can find flavor of red and black berry. Tannins are subtle and soft.

Food and wine pairing: With white meets, pot-au-feu, or scrambled eggs for brunch.

Ageing period: from 1 to 2 years.
