ABOUT THE WINE

An inaugural release, our 2017 Pinot Noir is a long overdue addition to our portfolio. Starting with delicious fruit from Sonoma County and California's Delta region, directly adjacent to Highway 12, our Pinot Noir represents classic California Pinot Noir characteristics and is very pleasing on the palate, and your wallet!

TASTING NOTES

Light garnet hue followed a nose of bright red fruit aromas. Think bing cherry compote with allspice meets cranberry relish on the mid palate with a subtle cedar and green tea leaf finish. Balanced and clean, resulting from soft minerality and light tannins. Pairs well with seared duck breast and fig reduction or a savory wild mushroom and dried cherry risotto.

WINEMAKING & VINEYARDS

Sourced from a number of our vineyard partners along California's Highway 12 that spans from Sonoma County through the cooler delta region and into Lodi, we had a great selection of fruit to craft our Highway 12 Pinot Noir. As we do with all our wines, we opted for the minimalist approach in our winemaking and let the quality of the fruit speak for itself.
