



Luzon Petit Verdot 2013

The wine area in Jumilla is situated southeast of Spain, north of the Murcia region on a plateau surrounded by mountains. Its climate is continental influenced by the Mediterranean sea with warm days and cool nights. The region has over 3,000 hours of sunshine and rainfall do not reach more than reaches 300 lt/m² year. Soils are poor in organic matter and coarse-textured stony, sandy clay with abundant limestone, giving small clusters, with good sugar concentration, excellent acidity and thicker skins.

Bodegas Luzón has about 600 hectares of vineyards, which are controlled by technicians throughout its entire growth cycle. this vineyard is divided into three farms or plots: Castillo Luzón, Castillo de Madax, and Finca La Solana.



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"Inky ruby. Blackberry, blueberry, licorice and cracked pepper on the nose. Juicy, gently sweet and focused, offering good depth to its dark berry and bitter cherry flavors, with a hint of licorice coming up with air. Chewy and structured but not at all hard. The cherry notes repeats on the finish, which is firmed by dusty, slow-building tannins."
