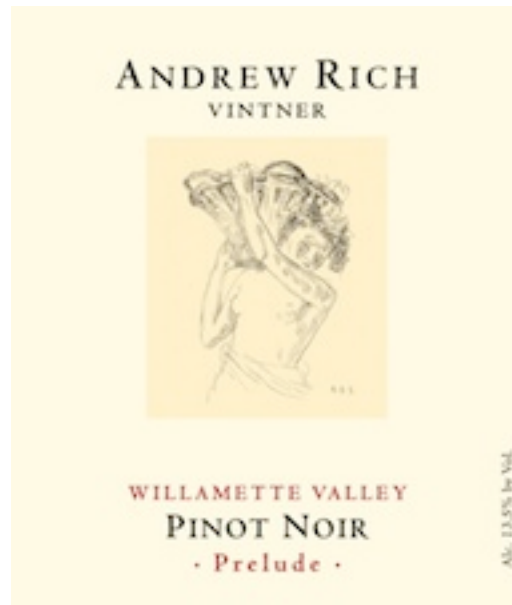


# ANDREW RICH WINES

## 2012 Pinot Noir Prelude

Our initial Pinot release from this much-vaunted vintage shows all the fruit and suppleness you could ask for without sacrificing that essential juicy acidity. (The miracle of blending!) The nose is spicy with a suggestion of beetroot, while the palate already seems well knit. Despite the ripe red fruit flavors, there's a transparency and liveliness here, and a softness on the finish, that make the wine simply irresistible. This shows best at 55-60 degrees. Tanzer 89 points.



Vineyards: Palmer Creek, Ribbon Ridge, Croft, La Colina, Dubay, Carlton Hill, Cherry Grove, Kelley Family

Ageing: Fifteen months in French oak barrels (20% new)

Alcohol: 14.1%

Bottled: April 2014, 1400 cases produced

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
