



2016 Other People's Pinot — Willamette Valley

Earthy, Spicy, Floral, Herb-framed flavors of Cherry

Maison Noir Wines: Garage Wines (Micro-Negociant) focusing on specific terroirs in Oregon by sourcing the best fruit possible from the Willamette Valley region of Oregon to produce wines which show the individuality of their respected sites.

Grapes: We source our fruit from several of the finest vineyards in the Willamette Valley, it is this combination of grapes from a variety of appellations that creates a wine that is broad and complex with many layers.

Winemaking: The 2016 harvest was the earliest ever starting in September and done by October, producing smaller berries which made for elegant wines with more aromatic lift and less tannins. Seven day cold soak, with an additional 18 days of skin contact, fermented in stainless steel; aged in French oak 30% new oak; aged 10 months. The 2016 *Other People's Pinot* is classic Oregon Pinot—earmark Willamette Valley. It is accessible; a great value; and stays true to vineyards from which it was born.
